



Dear Parents,

Well, we all enjoyed a wonderful afternoon of Coronation themed activities after our Coronation picnic on the field at lunchtime. Thank you to our Governors who also came to support. Luckily we managed to avoid the downpour! The feedback from the children was very positive and they are looking forward to the PTA Coronation event this Saturday from 2-4pm.

Attendance Reminder:

The Government discourages the taking of holidays in term time. Evidence shows that children who miss school do not achieve as well as those who attend regularly. Should you still choose to take a holiday with your child during this period the Local Authority will be informed as this will constitute an unauthorised absence. A Fixed Penalty Notice will then be issued to you [and your partner/husband] in accordance with section 444 of the Education Act 1996. The current rates payable by parents are £60 where the amount is paid within 21 days and £120 where the amount is paid within 28 days. This charge is per parent/carer per child. If the fixed penalty notice remains unpaid this could lead to prosecution in the Magistrate's Court.

Sports Day:

We will be holding our Sports Day on Monday 26th June with a reserve date of 3rd July. Parents are welcome to join KS1 in the morning, from approximately 9.15am onwards for their events and bring a picnic lunch. KS2 events will start at approximately 1.15pm and parents may also arrive earlier for a picnic lunch. Coloured T shirts for KS2 houses will be sent home closer to the time.
